Act No. 13/2003 on Employment

Article 86

- (1) Every worker/labour has the right to have protection for :
 - Occupational safety and health protection;

- ...

- (2) In order to protect the safety of workers/ labour and to realize optimal productivity, an occupational health and safety scheme shall be administered.
- (3) ...


Article 87 :

- (1)Every Company is under an obligation to apply an occupational safety and health management system that shall be integrated into the Company's management system.
