

Information Briefing Held for Public Institution on Preparation of Basic Safety Plan

- KOSHA held an information session on preparation of basic safety plans for 10 public institutions under the umbrella of the Ministry of Employment and Labor at the 5th floor meeting room of KTX Daejeon Station on the May 28th.
- As all public institutions are required to establish a basic safety plan for the purpose of securing safety management at workplaces and to submit the plan to the competent authorities and the Ministry of Economy and Finance by the end of June, KOSHA intends to help out those institutions preparing the plan through this information briefing session.
- The information briefing offered an explanation upon fundamentals of a basic safety plan prepared by KOSHA as well as a Q&A session to develop safety management measures reflecting distinctive features of each institution.
- A staff of KOSHA said, “We plan to provide more opportunities like today’s information briefing to help public institutions developing systematic plans to secure safety at workplaces for the purpose of ensuring implementation of practical occupational accident prevention activities.”
