- ☐ KOSHA launches the 'Program for Improvement on Level of Safety Awareness' designed to conduct self-imposed inspection on the level of safety awareness at worksites.
 - replacement of the Ò Introduced as a certification zero-accident movement which has been in operation for the past 40 years, this program aims to build a foundation to the safety awareness at workplaces from convert zero-accident oriented to prevention-oriented.
 - KOSHA plans to encourage effectively engaging in occupational accident prevention by presenting measures capable of measuring and improving the level of safety culture at worksites through this program to elevate the levels.
- ☐ This improvement program was developed and designed based on the advance indicators* diagnosing the level of safety culture at workplaces, which is subdivided into survey and in-depth programs.
 - * 4-step execution procedures (Plan-Do-Check-Action) concerning the 4 domains of safety culture (safety value, safe operation, safety training and safety communication);
 - The survey-type program is in a format where a survey is conducted on voluntary basis through online at worksites, comprised of 48 questionnaires for each class (management, manager & worker), 144 questionnaires in total.

- The outcome of the survey collected is to be printed out in a report on findings of diagnosis on safety awareness level at worksites and comprehensive assessment.
- The in-depth program targets a portion of worksites participating in the survey where KOSHA pays a visit to those worksites to offer consultations.
- ☐ A staff of KOSHA said, "We hope to help the business sites establishing prevention-oriented safety culture through processes of identifying and improving the level of safety awareness by fully utilizing the program for improvement on level of safety awareness."
