Major changes

- Fortified prevention of late/non-submission of proposal and discovery of non-submitting businesses.
- Program increases businesses awareness of the proposal submission system through diverse PR activities/notifications. Program's plan has been carefully revised/supplemented to ensure that increased discovery of non-submitting businesses decreases non-submissions.
- KOSHA to be responsible for PR and sending cooperation requests to safety and health agencies, private consignment companies, and safety inspection institutions to reduce the workload of inspection-receiving businesses.

Discovery of non-submitting businesses

Ask safety and health agencies and private consignment companies to report non-submitting businesses to KOSHA. - · Improved effectiveness of accident/death prevention system.
- Follow-up management via patrol checks (as done during program's trial operation) to overcome the limitations of a single check.
- Inspection conducted on whether businesses (those that have moved or constructed a new facility and/or have fewer than 50 employees) whose 2019 proposals were approved are actually implementing the safety and health measures stated in their proposal.
- Fee required to address factors that introduce high-risk of accidents/death (e.g. dangerous machinery and outdated processes) to be linked with KOSHA's financial support program.
