- The main contents of the MOU include: ▲ Promoting win-win cooperation projects for large and medium-sized enterprises, ▲ Cooperation in discovering and promoting corporate's best practices, and ▲ Cooperation in financial support and education for small and medium-sized enterprises to improve risks.
- This MOU was promoted amid the consensus of the two organizations to strengthen the weak safety capabilities of small and medium-sized enterprises and to spread a win-win cooperation model. In the future, KOSHA and the ISPF plan to carry out various projects to support the creation of a safe workplace for small and medium-sized enterprises and the establishment of a safety culture.
- First, the ISPF will support the participation of Hyundai Motor Group companies in the "Win-Win Cooperation Project for Large and Small Medium-sized Enterprises" promoted by KOSHA. This will present a new model of win-win cooperation in safety and health for small and medium-sized enterprises. In the future, the ISPF will identify cases of win-win cooperation and hold an award ceremony for outstanding businesses. The Foundation will also support small and mediumsized enterprises with the costs of improving dangerous facilities and introducing smart safety equipment.
