 - Eligibility for the contest will be given to venture companies and small-and-medium-sized enterprises with not greater than 7 years of existence as well as potential startup companies engaging in new technologies (including information technology) concerning products or services related to industrial safety, disaster prevention and fire safety.
 - At the same time, small-and-medium-sized enterprises of 3 years or less from the certification date of safety-related new technology development will be eligible for the contest.
 - The maximum of 10 teams (companies) will be selected, and the winners will be entitled to a total of \\$33 million prize money, including \\$10 million for the grand prize, mentor programs with experts, technical development funds and opportunities to participate in the International Safety and Health Exhibition.
